






# **About Hadhreen**

It has since grown into a humanitarian and development organization serving vulnerable communities across Sudan. Registered with the Humanitarian Aid Commission (HAC) in Sudan, Hadhreen has expanded globally with a formal presence in the UK and the USA, advancing its mission to support those in need.

# **Primary Interventions:**

- **1•** Emergency food aid and relief for trapped families, IDPs across 15 conflict-affected states in Sudan, and Sudanese refugees in Chad and Egypt
- **2•** Disaster response and epidemic control (including Combat Disease Vectors Campaign) in Al Jazeera, Sennar, Northern Sudan, Khartoum
- 3 Monthly direct cash transfers to vulnerable households
- 4 Sustainable WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) initiatives
- **5** Support services for survivors of gender-based violence (GBV)
- **6•** Facilitation of international grant transfers for partner Sudanese entities and INGOs.





**Total Spending** 

- •Hadhreen launched central Kitchens support Initiative in 2023 with 3 kitchens, has scaled to 180+ across Sudan, delivering 40+ million meals and serving over 400,000 individuals daily.
- •To strengthen food security and women's economic resilience, Hadhreen launched a home farming initiative in Sennar and Khartoum states, providing over 100 women with seeds, tools, pest control, and agricultural counseling.


Central Kitchens numbers across 2024

# Food Baskets for Refugees – 1,500 Families

Hadhreen delivered 1,500 food baskets to **Sudanese refugees in Chad and Egypt**, supplying essential staples to families facing displacement and hunger.

### Eid al-Adha – 14,000+ Families

Hadhreen distributed meat from 206 calves, 320 sheep, and 5 goats to 14,000+ vulnerable families across 13 states and refugee camps, ensuring dignified Eid celebrations with protein-rich meals.

Hadhreen delivered 1,500 food baskets to Sudanese refugees in Chad and Egypt, supplying essential staples to families facing displacement and hunger.

### Zakat al-Fitr – More than 800 Families

At the end of the month of Ramadan, Hadhreen provided sacks of corn as Zakat al-Fitr to more than 800 families. This initiative came in response to a request from our committed supporters.

# **Compacting Vector-Borne Disease Campaign**

To combat the spread of epidemic and endemic diseases, Hadhreen provided manual pumps and pesticides, along with training volunteers on spraying techniques and pesticide mixing methods, in coordination with local health officers

Supporting primary health centers with essential medicines to enhance health response in affected areas.

### **Impact**

- \* 4 states (Northern State, Sennar State, Khartoum State, and River Nile State)
  - \* Improved Living Conditions: Provision of shelters and improved housing environments contributed to safer and healthier conditions for vulnerable communities.
  - \* Access to Clean Water: Ensuring access to safe drinking water through restoration and protection of sources.
  - \* Reduced Epidemic Spread: Targeted interventions such as vector control campaigns and medicine distribution helped reduce the transmission of epidemic diseases and lowered infection rates.

# Direct cash distribution for vulnerable families and Monthly Sponsorship for orphans:

Hadhreen Organization provides monthly financial assistance to children under the age of eighteen who have lost a parent, as well as to orphans and widows of the martyrs of the December Revolution and subsequent events, in the states of Khartoum, Nile River, Kassala, Gedaref, Gezira, North Kordofan, Sennar, the Northern State, West Kordofan, and South Darfur.

The program aims to meet basic needs such as food and healthcare, thereby supporting the stability of vulnerable families and helping mothers build a better future for their children. In addition to monthly transfers, support is also provided during Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha.













# **WASH Projects**





#### Natural Water Coolers

Hadhreen installed 17 natural cooler units in public schools and mosques, providing sustainable and hygienic drinking water without the need for power.

The system is using heat exchange theory, which help reducing dependency on power and contributes to environmental sustainability, while supporting education and community resilience in a water-scarce region. The initiative improves public health, especially in mosques and crowded public schools, by ensuring access to clean water and reducing the risk of disease transmission through shared cups.



#### Solar-Powered Water Station – Al-Obeid

At Al-Obeid Secondary School for Girls in North Kordofan, Hadhreen established a solar-powered water station that supplies clean and reliable water to both students and the local community.
