The Semi-Annual Report



In the first half of 2025, successful partnerships continued with international donors, including the World Food Program (WFP), the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), as well as a number of international and Sudanese organizations and Sudanese diaspora networks. These partnerships enabled Hadhreen to sustain several ongoing projects and expand the water access and WASH projects.

The escalation of armed clashes prior to the liberation of Khartoum State by the Sudanese Armed Forces led to the suspension of many central kitchens operating in areas previously under the control of the rebel militia. This was due to repeated attacks on kitchen facilities, posing extreme risk to the supervisors and families benefiting from these services. The criminal militia not only looted food supplies, money, and kitchen utensils, but also arrested and tortured several kitchen supervisors. In a horrific escalation, several supervisors and volunteers were brutally killed, with some of their bodies mutilated and hung on public streets.

The memory of these unknown heroes will remain etched in our hearts and minds. Their noble sacrifices are the driving force behind our continued commitment to respond to every call for help, as much as our capacity allows.



- :: Over 31 million meals are distributed through central kitchens.



nd Crisis Mitigation Programme Central Kitchen Support



In January, the operation of central kitchens continued across four states. Starting in February, operations were limited to the kitchens specified under the funding provided by the World Food Programme in the localities of Khartoum, Jabal Awliya, and East Nile.

During the holy month of Ramadan, thanks to collected Zakat al-Fitr donations, Hadhreen was able to restore support to all kitchens across the four states until the end of May.

Additional specialized support was provided to kitchens serving separate meals for children, with Hadhreen committing to supply essential food commodities for their daily meals.










Home-based Farming

The home farming initiative continued, targeting 129 women in Khartoum and Sennar states. These women cultivated available spaces in their homes with the support of agricultural inputs and guidance. After weeks of hard labor, they harvested high-quality vegetables, providing crucial support for their families in extremely difficult conditions.





Beneficiaries 17,000+ Households






Hadhreen distributed the meat of 120 calves, 228 sheep, and 2 goats through central kitchens, shelter centers, and to vulnerable families across 15 states and Sudanese refugee camps in Chad. The number of beneficiaries exceeded 17,000 families.



Hadhreen continued its efforts to support women survivors of conflict-related sexual violence, providing psychosocial assistance and protection services. The organization also facilitated the safe and dignified return of some survivors to their communities of origin following the liberation of those areas from militia control by the Sudanese Armed Forces.







Vector Control Campaign

To contain epidemic outbreaks, Hadhreen provided shoulder-mounted manual sprayers and pesticides, and trained volunteers in three states (White Nile, Khartoum, and Al Jazirah) on proper spraying techniques and pesticide mixing under the supervision of local health officers. These efforts significantly contributed to epidemic prevention.









Natural Water Coolers

Hadhreen installed 8 cooling unit in public schools. This function is based on heat exchange theory without requiring energy input, promoting environmental sustainability. The initiative seeks to improve public health by ensuring access to safe drinking water and reducing disease transmission risks in public schools.

:: Orphans under 18 who have lost their father


:: Widows of martyrs of the December Revolution and subsequent events


:: Orphans and university-level siblings of martyrs (specifically where the martyr was the main provider)

The monthly support aims to help cover basic needs, with additional grants provided to orphans during Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha.








Water Stations

In response to the urgent need for clean water, particularly after the looting of solar-powered water systems by militia groups, Hadhreen launched a water station rehabilitation and construction project.

11 water stations were rehabilitated in the states of Sennar, Al Jazirah, Khartoum, and River Nile. The rehabilitation included restoring solar energy systems, civil works, and checking water connections.
